

SA VAERS is an independent alternative vaccine adverse events reporting system, by the people, for the people.


The focus of SA VAERS is to give survivors and victims a voice, enhance data transparency, and strengthen accountability for negative effects, injury or death following the C19 injection.

EVENTS


According to the National Institute for Communicable Diseases, an adverse event following immunisation (AEFI) is ANY negative health event that happens after a person receives a vaccine. All health events after vaccination are important to investigate. Therefore, whilst some mild and short-lasting symptoms are predictable, moderately severe, severe and long-term side effects are not acceptable, and should be fully investigated. All adverse events should be reported, including those that have improved clinically or resolved spontaneously.
